

WILLOWICK PLANS TO BUILD FACILITY IN TOWN OF BELOIT

TOWN OF BELOIT - Consolidated Construction Co. Inc., a design/build firm headquartered in Appleton, has been selected to build the new Willowick Residential Care Apartment Complex and Community-Based Residential Facility (CBRF) in the Town of Beloit.

Willowick Assisted Living operates existing facilities in Beloit, Clinton and Janesville.

The newest expansion in the Town of Beloit will be more than 28,000 square feet, consisting of a 12-unit residential care apartment facility and 24-unit community-based residential facility. Amenities include apartments with private bathrooms, and the ability to control air temperature in each living space.

Willowick was started by Rock County residents Frieda Pulkowski, a registered nurse, and Lori Schlosser, a health care administrator, who believe comprehensive, quality care and services can be provided in a beautiful setting at a reasonable rate. They are active in all aspects of the management and day-to-day operations of the Willowick facilities.

Willowick communities are Diamond Accreditation Program participants, a program administered by the Wisconsin Assisted Living Association (WALA) that provides tools, support, and education necessary to help assisted living communities establish and maintain their own customized quality improvement program.
