The project will add a 52-apartment, four-story building at the corner of Fourth Street and Grand Avenue with potential plans for two additional apartment buildings to be built on space closer to the Rock River. The lofts are named after the Wright and Wagner dairy that used to be in Beloit. In December of 2019, HCP CEO Rob Gerbitz told the Beloit Daily News the first building is expected to open in late 2020.
