Community testing priority is for those who are symptomatic, been exposed to an individual who tested positive for COVID-19, or cannot afford a test.

SYMPTOMS

- Fever
- Cough
- Difficulty breathing/shortness of breath
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache (new or different)
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
